## WEAVING:

- Basket any technique

## SPINNING:

- Designer yarn (boucle, slub)
- It's a wrap! Make a scarf, shawl or stole with handspun
- Any other item make with handspun

If there are other categories you'd prefer to enter for example; knitting or crochet instead of spinning or weaving, so long as you are enjoying making and working with fibre feel free to sub out the boxes and fill up your board with items made for other categories – let's fill the fairs with items that bring us joy!
